burn gasoline in the engine, so they don't pollute the air. They use electricity stored on the car in batteries.

Sometimes, 12 or 24 batteries, or more, are needed to power the car. Just like a remote-controlled car, an electric car has an electric motor that turns the wheels and a battery to run the motor. Electricity, the same energy that lights your lamps and runs your TV, is stored in batteries on an electric car. The batteries can be like the batteries you find in flashlights or in regular gasoline cars. To get the battery ready to roll, you have to charge it. This process isn't much different from the way you charge the portable devices you carry around every day: Your cell phone, MP3 player, or digital camera. The difference is that you deal with a much bigger gadget that carries you around instead.

What do people need to light their homes and drive cars? Energy! Energy gives power to many things we need and use. Most of the energy people use comes from coal, oil, and gas. They are called fossil fuels. Those fuels come from fossils under the ground.
